





Vocabulary: Costume Catwalk

Project Objective:

Students will participate in a fun and engaging costume “catwalk” party where they will dress up as a character representing a specific job. During the catwalk, each student will give a short physical description of themselves and explain the job they do, including where they perform it. This activity aims to develop students’ speaking skills, vocabulary related to physical descriptions and occupations, and confidence when presenting in front of others.

Costume & Creativity	Your costume is amazing, super creative, and shows your job perfectly!	Your costume looks great and shows your job clearly.	Your costume shows the job a little, but could use more details.	It's hard to tell what job your costume represents.
Physical Description	You describe yourself with lots of details (3-4!) and speak confidently.	You give a clear description with 2-3 details.	You only give 1-2 details, or you need more confidence.	You give very few or no details.
