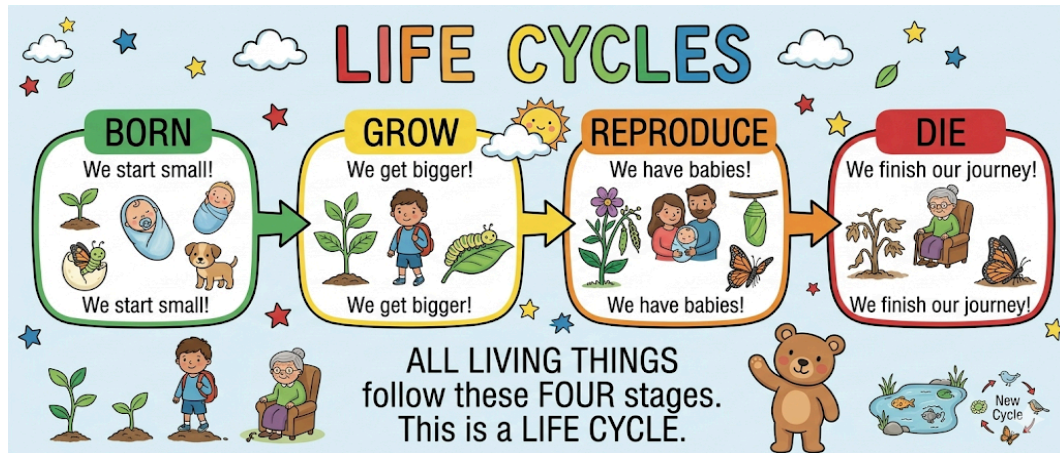
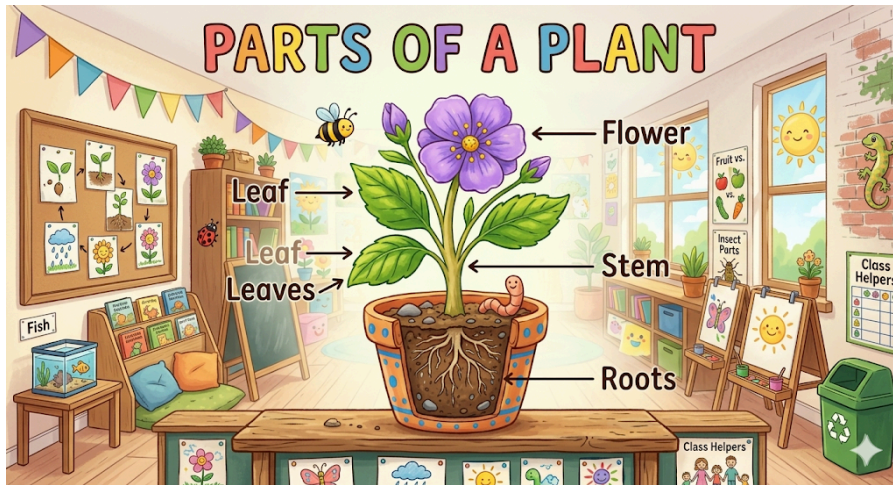

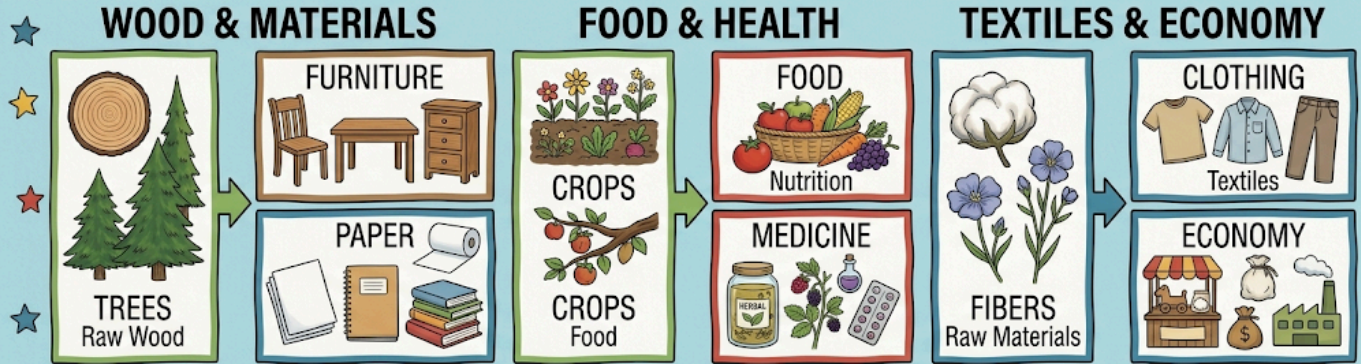
WILD PLANTS follow natural rules; no people's help.
