

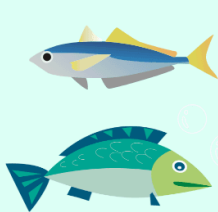

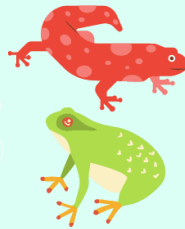
5 Groups of Vertebrates

Fish



- Cold-blooded
- Gills
- Scales and fins
- Lay eggs or live birth in water

Amphibians



- Cold-blooded
- Gills and lungs
- Thin moist skin
- Lay jelly-like eggs in water

Reptiles



- Cold-blooded
- Lungs
- Scales
- Lay leathery eggs on land or live birth

Birds



- Warm-blooded
- Lungs
- Feathers
- Lay hard eggs on land

Mammals



- Warm-blooded
- Lungs
- Hair
- Live birth and feed young milk

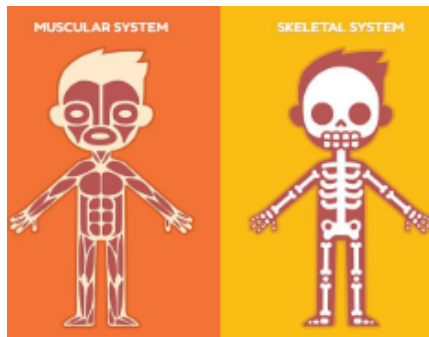

| I <u>am</u> | I' <u>m not</u> | <u>am</u> I? |
| he she <u>is</u> it | he she <u>isn't</u> is | he? <u>is</u> she? it? |
| we you <u>are</u> they | we you <u>aren't</u> they | we? <u>are</u> you? they? |

VERB TO BE (PAST TENSE)

| AFFIRMATIVE | NEGATIVE | INTERROGATIVE |
|-------------|--------------|---------------|
| I was | I wasn't | Was I...? |
| You were | You weren't | Were you...? |
| He was | He wasn't | Was he...? |
| She was | She wasn't | Was she...? |
| It was | It wasn't | Was it...? |
| We were | We weren't | Were we...? |
| You were | You weren't | Were you...? |
| They were | They weren't | Were they...? |

SIMPLE PAST TENSE

The simple past tense describes actions that happened and ended in the past.

- +** Subject + V2 (past form) + O.
- Subject + did not + V1 (base form) + O.
- ?** Did + Subject + V1 (base form) + O?

| Affirmative | Negative | Question |
|-------------------|------------------------|---------------------|
| I played soccer. | I didn't play soccer. | Did I play soccer? |
| You watched TV. | You didn't watch TV. | Did you watch TV? |
| He ate lunch. | He didn't eat lunch. | Did he eat lunch? |
| She read news. | She didn't read news. | Did she read news? |
| It made noise. | It didn't make noise. | Did it make noise? |
| We drink tea. | We didn't drink tea. | Did we drink tea? |
| They studied art. | They didn't study art. | Did they study art? |
